

Information COVID -19 (27)

To the entire IST community,

In view of the current pandemic situation and in accordance with the declaration of the state of emergency, which determines the establishment of the red phase of the IST Contingency Plan (https://tecnico.ulisboa.pt/pt/coronavirus/medidas/), the beginning of the spring semester of 2020/2021 (next March 1st) will occur with 100% synchronous theoretical and practical classes in all course units, without exception. The "at the lab" laboratorial classes, even in the on/off regime like the one during the 1st semester, will not occur in the beginning of the semester, since the IST Contingency Plan only allows them from its orange phase.

In the week of March 22nd (before Easter week) the contingency plan of IST will be reassessed, in view of the evolution of the pandemic and the determinations and recommendations of the authorities. During this week, before Easter, the school will be informed about the school's second semester's regime starting on April 5th (resumption of school activities after Easter).

Following this information to the whole community, the IST Pedagogical Council and Management Council will send specific guidelines to the Department Chairs, Coordinators and Course Delegates. These recommendations aim at preparing and planning the second semester in more detail, under the current circumstances. I therefore recommend to the entire IST academic community, teachers and students, that as of next week, they contact the Department Chairs, Coordinators or Course Delegates (namely the students) in order to clarify any doubts or request additional information.
