

Declaration

I the undersigned (applicant's full name) _____, holder of Identity Card (or passport) no. _____, of _____ nationality, as applicant to Instituto Superior Técnico, Universidade de Lisboa, in the academic year of 2026/2027, in accordance with the International Student Statute, hereby declare, upon my honour, for all due purposes provided for in Article 3 (2) of the International Student Statute in its present version as published in Decree-law no. 62/2018, of August 6th, that:

- a) **I am not a Portuguese citizen, nor of any other Member State of the European Union.**
- b) **I am not a family member¹⁾ of a Portuguese citizen, nor of a citizen of any Member State of the European Union.**
- c) **As a non-national of a Member State of the European Union, on the 1st January of the year of application, I have not resided legally in Portugal for more than two years uninterruptedly, nor am I the offspring of parents in that situation (resident permits for higher education studies are not relevant for this purpose).**
- d) **On the 1st January of the year of application I do not enjoy equal rights and obligations status granted by any international treaty signed by the Portuguese State and the State of my nationality.**

¹⁾Family members of Portuguese citizens or of citizens of a Member State of the European Union is deemed to refer, regardless of his/her nationality, to:

- i) The spouse of an European Union citizen;
- ii) The legally established non-marital partner of an European Union citizen, or the person in a durable relationship with the European Union citizen, if duly attested by the relevant authority in the Member State of residence;
- iii) The under 21 years old direct descendent of an European Union citizen or under his/her charge, as well as of his/her spouse or partner as established above;
- iv) The direct ascendant; under the responsibility of a European Union citizen, as well as of his/her spouse or partner as established above.
